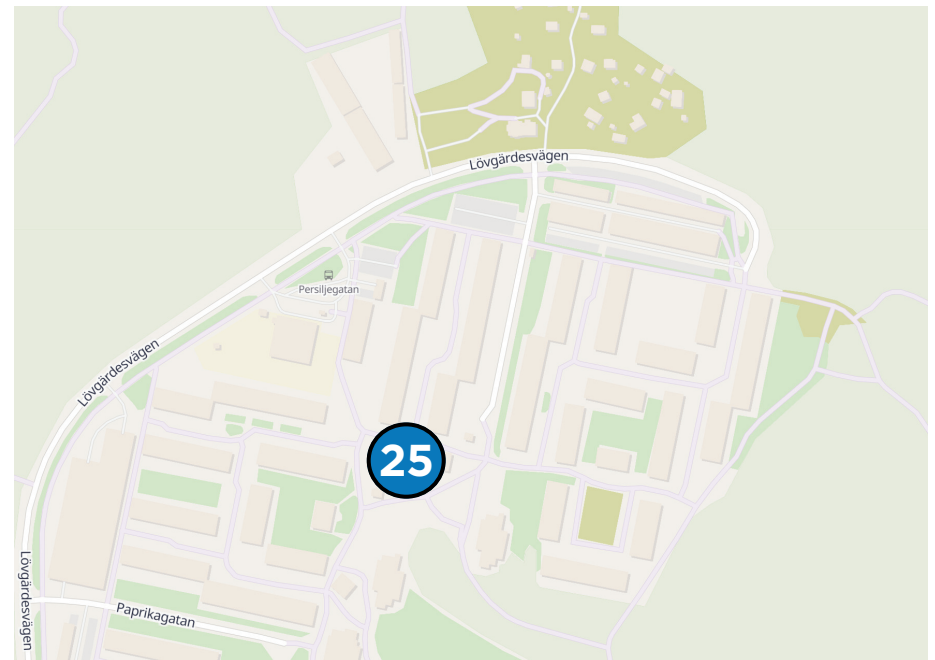

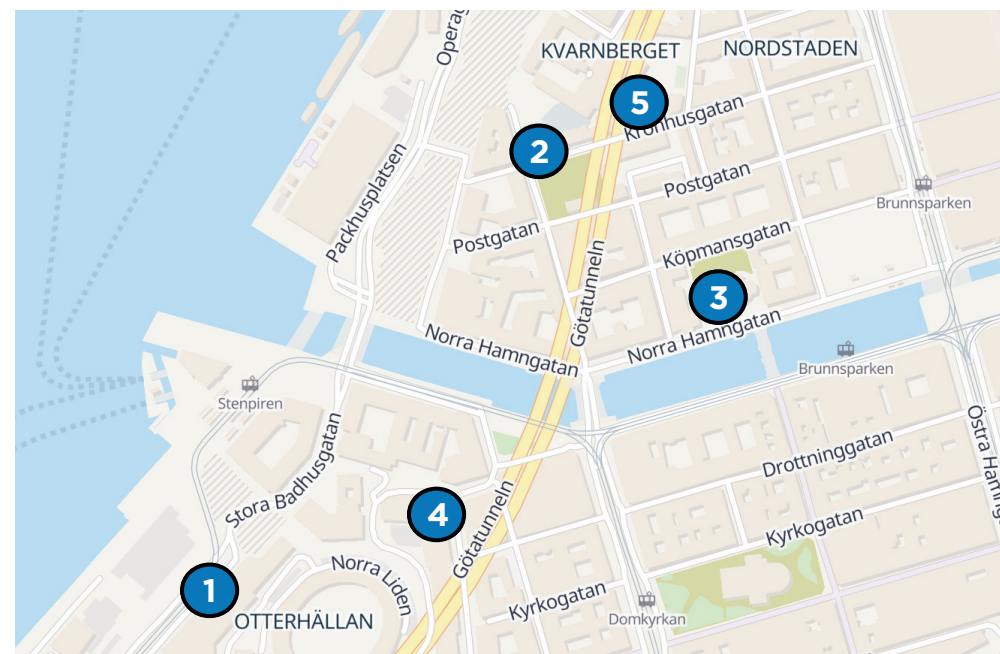

We also offer condoms, hepatitis A & B vaccinations, wound care, counseling with a social worker, and more.



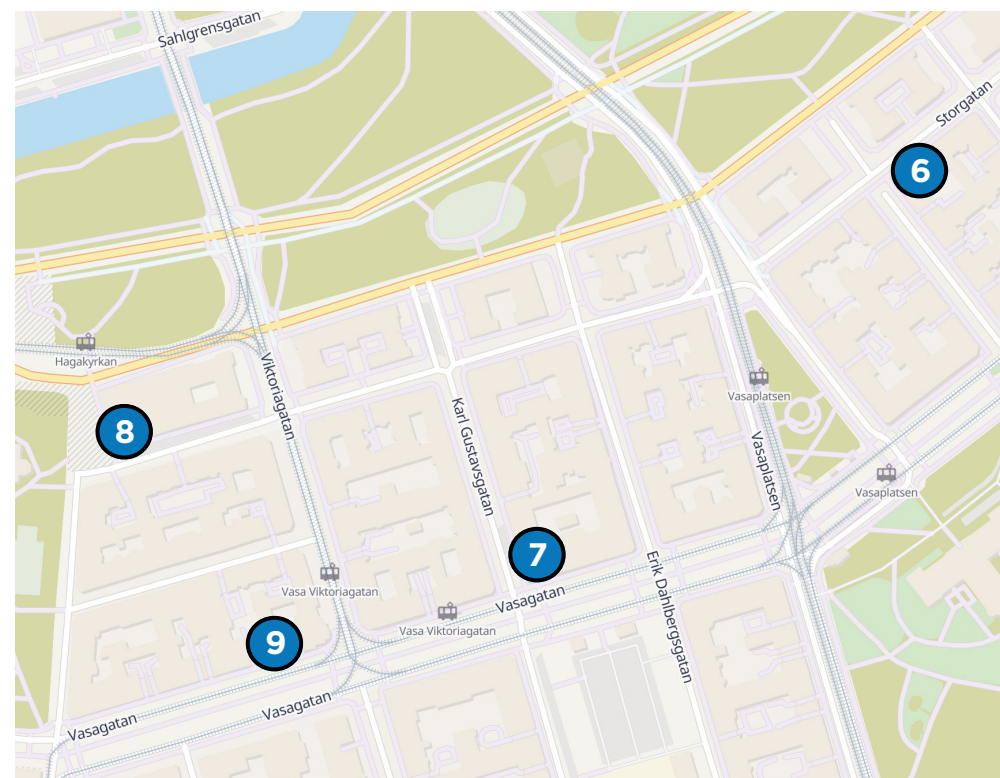
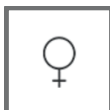
